His popularity led him to be chosen as both the FHA "Mr. Preferred" and the GAA "Honey".

Among his athletic accomplishments were being selected as Class A All-Conference in football, basketball, and baseball, Captain and Outstanding Player for 1976 – 77, Honorable Mention All-State Defensive Back, All Valley Football First Team Defensive Back, and left fielder on the State Baseball Championship Team of 1976.

After graduation from Santa Cruz, Chris continued his education at Northern Arizona University where he graduated in 1982.

Following family tradition of community activism, Chris was active in supporting the Eloy Little League while serving as Director of Eloy's Leisure Services department.

He returned to Eloy to serve as its City Manager. He later went on to be City Manager at Superior, Arizona, National City, California, and San Leandro, California where he is currently employed.
