**MONTHLY REPORTS**

1. Business Manager’s Report – *Mrs. Sharon Rodriguez*

Mrs. Rodriguez reported an update regarding Arizona Legislation need to approve the override of the Constitutional Aggregate Expenditure Limit, which will affect all school districts. If the legislation does not approve the override, the district will need to cut \$684,000.00 from the budget on April 1, 2023.

Gym floor repairs are complete. The second inspection of the Air Handler project is being scheduled for this week.

There was a decision regarding the Arizona Legislation needing to approve the override of the Constitutional Aggregate Expenditure Limit and the financial effects all Arizona school districts would endure.

2. Food Service Director's Report – *Mr. Ricardo Cazares*  
Mr. Cazares reported the cafeteria served 785 breakfast meals and 2,591 lunch meals for the month of October.  
The Expense to Revenue Report was submitted.

Mr. Ibarra reported he will attend the AIA - 2A Conference in Phoenix on November 4<sup>th</sup>.

Coaching volunteers for boys and girls soccer met all requirements from Human Resources to start coaching.

Fall sports are officially completed and neither team made the post season. Voting for All Region took place the week of October 29<sup>th</sup> – November 2<sup>nd</sup> .

Winter sports officially started Monday, October 31, 2022. All winter sports have been brought back for the 22-23 season.

Athletic department is looking for a volunteer for the Cheer Sponsor. Mrs. Ogle inquired about a Cheer Sponsor. Mr. Ibarra stated an individual expressed interest but has not come in to apply for the position. Mrs. Reyes stated there is not enough cheer uniforms in school colors however; there are black uniforms which could be used until next fiscal year. Mrs. Ogle approved of the black uniforms and was pleased there would be a cheer squad.
